

The West Valley Projects and Improvements – report update - 1/25/17

The West Valley Range was first utilized by us as a shooting venue in 1974. Several different firing line / target setups in different locations were tried with the current layout being established in the early 80's. Berm excavations and backstop constructions have occurred many times in these 40 plus years. The Parking Lot was first expanded in the late 80's. The Concrete Bench was constructed in '94. The permanent Roof over that bench was added in 2004. The next couple years you'll see these changes in the West Valley....
